Project Narrative \*

Judging a GIS-based student research poster competition at the Montana State University Earth Sciences Student Colloquium (ESSC).

The ESSC is an annual event organized and fundraised by graduate students in the Department of Earth Sciences at Montana State University. The public event includes student research talks, a poster session, a raffle, and a keynote address. This year, the event will be held online on Thursday and Friday, April 22nd-23rd. The goal of the ESSC is to advance, support, and celebrate student research in the Earth Sciences. GIS is one of the principle academic tracks in MSU's Department of Earth Sciences and is widely applied across all avenues of research in our department -- from geology and paleontology to snow sciences and city planning.

We ask for MAGIP's support in judging and providing small cash prizes for a GIS-based student research poster competition. The number of prizes and award amount can be decided on by MAGIP. In the past, MAGIP has offered three prizes for first, second, and third place, which amounted to \$100, \$50, and \$25, respectively. Normally, at our

past events, MAGIP sent three MAGIP members to serve as judges. The current plan is to divide the event into two days. The poster session on each day (April 22nd and 23rd) is currently scheduled from 1-4 pm MST. On each day, the poster session will be divided into one-hour blocks based on the research subject (e.g., city planning, ecology, geography, geology, paleontology, snow science, etc.). We will make sure to send you the abstracts and program in advance so you know which posters to judge.

The poster competition will provide both support and recognition for students conducting exceptional GIS-based research. We anticipate, based on its impact in years past, that the poster competition will galvanize student GISbased research in our department and will help encourage students to pursue GIS-based work as a career.
